We mentioned in January that one of the men that graduated from our Bible College, and his family were moving to Santa Cruz, and looking at starting a new church. We praise the Lord that they have now been having service for the past month, or a little more, and the Lord has really been blessing them. They passed out invitations for several days before the first service, and even though they had torrencial rain, they still had close to fifteen people come. When it rains in this area the water can get several feet deep because of drainage problems. Each service they have been having fifteen to twenty people come and visitors in most services. They now have a group and faithful members that are coming and some are even beginning to help out in the church. There is one couple that is older and the husband is blind, that helps with the music and sings specials on a regular basis. We have been praying much for Juan and his family as they begin the ministry there and the needs that they have. They are still in need of chairs, a church sign, children's tables and chairs and a few other things. If you would like to help this new work get off the ground, and continue to reach this area with the gospel, please let us know.
