We sat up tables and handed out drink and popcorn, along with invitations to the church and a new tract that we had printed about why we are different as a church. The tract tells how we are different in three main areas, one, that our focus is on reaching and helping every part of the family, two, that the Bible is what guides what we believe and do and no other book, and three, the only way to salvation and heaven is through Jesus Christ and what He did on the cross and not by works or religion. In all we handed out several hundred of each and made contact with many people. We even had a family that has been coming to church that we spoke with on that day. We praise the Lord to be able to share the gospel with those in our community.
